

“Counseling Corner” Items for Newsletter – February 4, 2009

All Timpanogos High School students will have the opportunity to create their 2009-2010 schedules through the on-line “Class Choice” program. The following information will guide students through this process.

11th grade Group SEOPs were held February 3rd and 4th
Class Choice will be available for current 11th graders beginning Monday, March 9th at 3:00 PM through Thursday, March 12th at 10:00PM

10th grade Group SEOPs begin March 4th and 5th in English Classes

Class Choice will be available for current 10th graders beginning Monday, April 6th at 3:00 PM through Thursday, April 9th at 10:00PM

Class Choice will be available for students to use 24 hours a day during this time period. Classes are available on a first come first serve basis, so the earlier you get online the greater the likelihood of getting classes you want.

Computer Access to Class Choice: All students will be able to login and create their 2009-2010 schedules from any computer with internet access. Students who do not have access to a computer at home can use the computer labs at Timpanogos High School in the Counseling Office, Media Center or Writing Lab before or after school or during their lunch hour.
